

STUDENT CONDUCT FORM

The Howard County Public School System policy (#8110) is in effect for students who participate in Foreign Travel Study Programs. Although all students in the HCPSS have already signed copies of some of the other policies that apply to foreign travel in their schools, we would like to insure that all participants, their parents, and trip leaders understand them and their associated penalties.

In addition, students shall not:

1. Engage in any "body modification" (i.e. tattoos, body piercing, or similar behavior.)
2. Operate any motor vehicle.
3. Participate in any extreme sports, except sports that are a part of the program and are covered by accident insurance.
4. Engage in any activity which could be considered dangerous to the health, safety, or welfare of the student, or any member of the group.

All trip leaders are required to review the policies and penalties for any violations. Student Participant and parent(s) are to initial below that each policy was clearly explained to them.
